Papers & Presentation

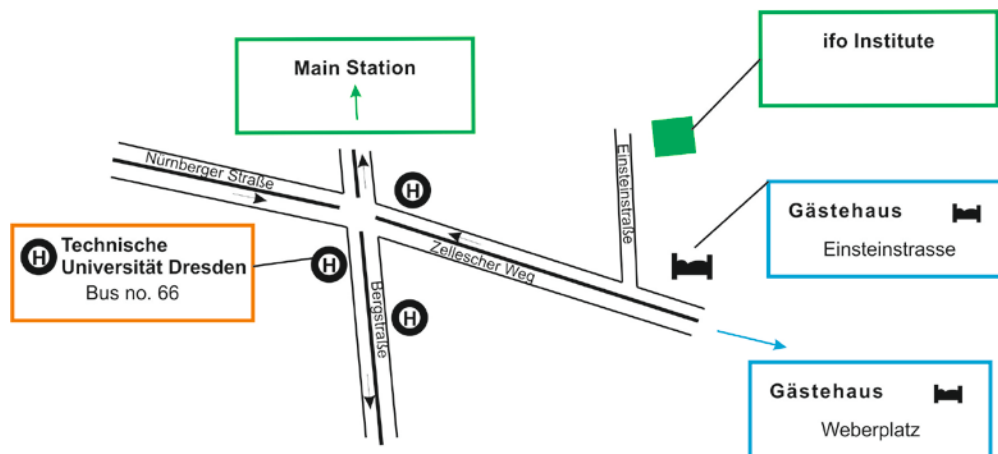
